

Ransburg Scout Reservation 2020 Scout Registration and Payment Schedule

The \$150 Unit Reservation Deposit, required when making a registration, is non-refundable under all circumstances. \$100 of this deposit will automatically be applied to youth registrations when final fees are calculated. \$50 will be retained as a reservation fee.

Deposit: A non-refundable Scout Deposit of \$50 per Scout is due on or before February 15th to reserve the number of spaces needed for your Scouts. Unutilized \$50 deposits can be transferred to another Scout, but cannot be refunded. After February 1 and/or when a session fills to capacity, the availability of additional camper spaces will be determined by the Camp Director.

Payments & Discounts: Final payments are determined based on the date payments are received. An Early Discount of \$20.00 per Scout will be applied to all transactions conducted on or before April 15th. A Late Charge of \$25 will be applied to all transactions conducted after May 15th. **Webelos who cross over to a Scouts BSA Troop between 01/01/20 and the beginning of camp are eligible for the Early Payment Rate to encourage their attendance with your Troop.**

Provisional Scouts: An individual Scout not camping with their Troop is considered a "Provisional Scout". To register a provisional scout, you will need to contact the CAC office. The Ransburg Staff will work to associate Provisional Scouts with a Troop, or form a Provisional Troop.

Ransburg Scout Reservation 2020 Campsite Changes and Preference Policy

In order to provide an unparalleled experience to all Troops who attend Ransburg Scout Reservation, we are developing new campsites across camp as laid out in the site master plan. For the Summer of 2020, we are specifically developing and expanding sites along Ridge 1. As part of this exciting process:

1) Campsite Names Will Change

Names of all campsites at Ransburg will change effective for Summer 2020. New names have been thoughtfully chosen to highlight the outstanding natural resources and rich history of our surrounding area. Each ridge will follow an established theme, making navigation simpler for those joining us for their very first time. These names will be placed on temporary signage ahead of Summer 2019.

2) Campsite Capacities Will Be Updated

Many campsites will have either 8 or 15 permanently placed platforms for tents (16-30 participants per site). This will allow for a variety of Troops to be matched to a site that best fits their size and needs. Updated permanent site capacities are listed, and a limited number of temporary tents could still be placed in many sites. We will continue to work with larger Troops to secure multiple campsites.

3) Campsite Selection

We understand and appreciate that the campsite is a Troop's home while at summer camp. We will work hard to register Troops into campsites that suite their unique needs and preferences, while also being considerate of the other Troops who plan to attend.

Projected numbers of youth and adult attendees are requested at the time of registration and should be confirmed with the Per Scout Deposit by February 15th, 2020. After this date, campsites that are not at capacity will be reviewed on an as needed basis for modification.

4) Registering Your Troop for 2020

Registration for each week of the Summer 2020 season will open during the corresponding Summer 2019 week, on **Thursdays at 7pm**. Troops in camp who would like to schedule time to walk the new campsite plan are encouraged to do so on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and as needed for the remainder of the week. A 2020 selection worksheet will be available at Ransburg and Kreitenstein for those units in camp, and our team would happy to facilitate a discussion of specific considerations and preferences by phone or email with Troops planning to join us for Summer 2020 who are not on site this summer. The draft campsite map with modified locations and names is available for all to use.

5) Registration Confirmation

All registrations will be reviewed by the Ransburg Scout Reservation Staff, in coordination with the Crossroads of America Outdoor Program Team. All registrations will be confirmed within a month from when they are initiated in the Scouting Event system. We welcome discussion of specific consideration from any Troop in terms of needs of accommodation, and we look forward to serving you again in 2020!
